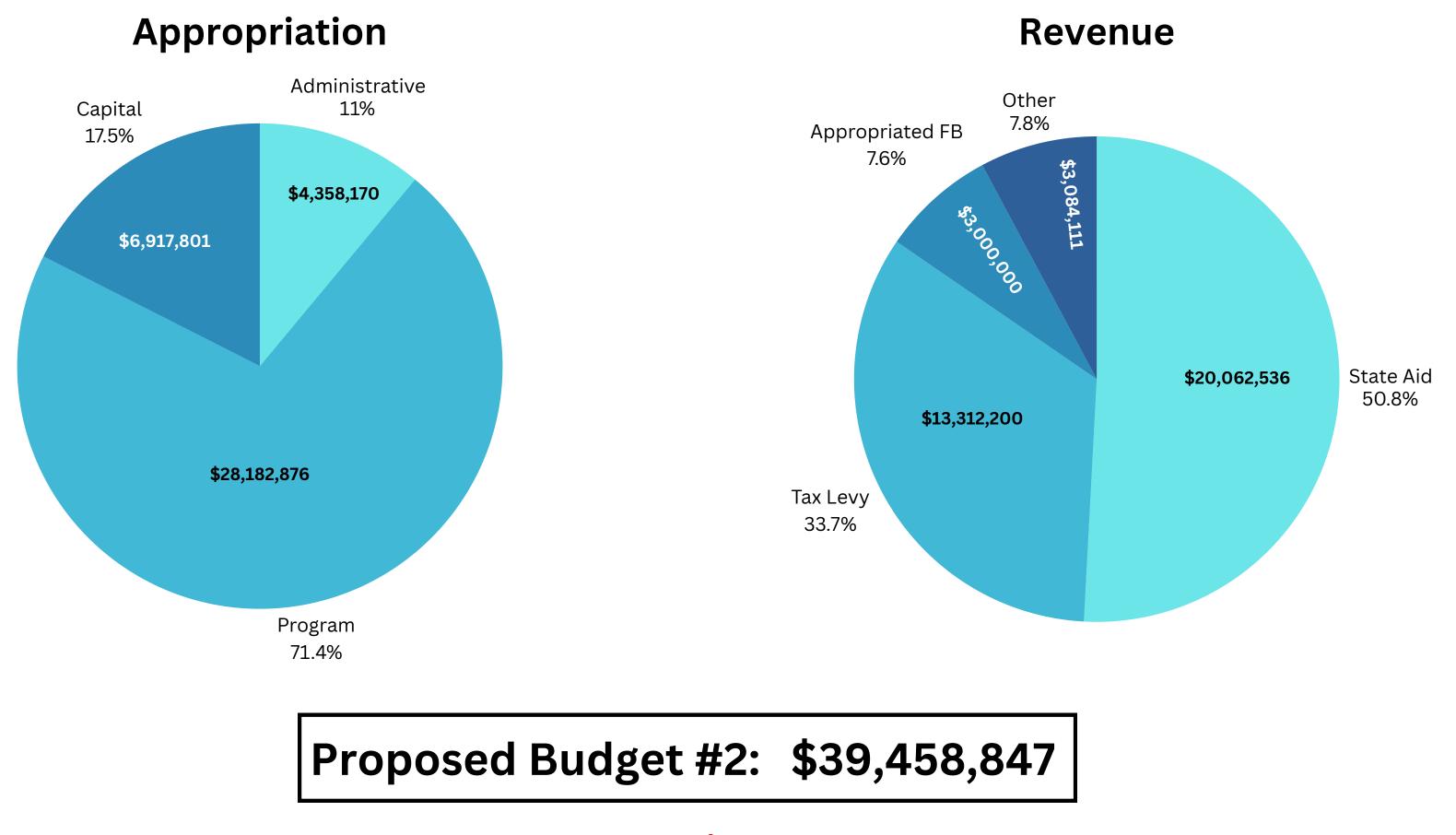
<u>2025-26 Proposed Budget #2</u> Jordan-Elbridge CSD



First failed budget from May 20, 2025: \$39,585,000 (1.5% tax increase)

\$2,043,847 (+5.46%) Increase from 24-25: \$13,312,200 (+0.85% tax increase) **New Proposed Tax Levy:**

- The proposed budget #2 maintains all student programming and extracurricular activities.
- Changes from first failed budget (-\$126,153):
 - Removed Superintendent's budgeted contractual entitlements (-\$35,000 retention & -\$51,153 vacation buyout)
 - Decreased school bus purchase spending (-\$35,000)
 - Eliminated Tax Collector stipend (-\$5,000)
 - Proposed tax levy increase lowered from 1.5% to 0.85%
- REVOTE Tuesday, June 17th from 7am-9pm at the JE High School Events Entrance.
- Failure to pass this second vote will result in the adoption of the contingency budget by the Board of Education. A contingency budget means:
 - No community use of school buildings when school is not in session
 - No new equipment purchases, including school buses
 - Field trips and non-essential supply purchases are limited
 - Athletics and extracurricular activities are impacted
