RESOLUTION CALLING THE 2021 ANNUAL DISTRICT MEETING AND ELECTION OF THE JORDAN-ELBRIDGE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING RELATED MATTERS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Jordan-Elbridge Central School District, Onondaga and Cayuga Counties, New York as follows:

Section 1. Section 3. That voting on: (I) the 2021-2022 annual school budget, which will appear on the ballot as **Proposition No. 1**; (II) the election of one (1) member to the Board; and (III) such other business as is authorized by law, will take place at the Annual District Meeting and Election on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 (the "Annual District Meeting and Election"), at the Jordan-Elbridge High School building, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Savings Time (E.D.S.T.), and that such voting shall be by voting machine. All other qualified voters can request a ballot by contacting the District Clerk at 315-689-8500 x5002 or by emailing bfall@jecsd.org. All ballots must be returned to the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on May 18, 2021.

<u>Section 4.</u> That except as hereinafter provided, the official Notice of the aforesaid public hearing and Annual District Meeting and Election shall be in the following form:
